This mandate is primarily carried out through the undertaking of various audits of the public sector. Audit results are typically reported publicly to the legislative branch of government.

Reporting to Regional Council through the Audit and Finance Standing Committee, the Municipal Auditor General champions the mission of the office to deliver independent audits that strengthen accountability and encourage improved efficiency and effectiveness of municipal programs. They are accountable for exercising all powers, duties, and functions as defined by provincial legislation and municipal by-laws through conducting performance auditing. By providing independent and objective insights into the effectiveness of public expenditures and operations, the Municipal Auditor General contributes to more informed, transparent, and overall improved governmental performance.
